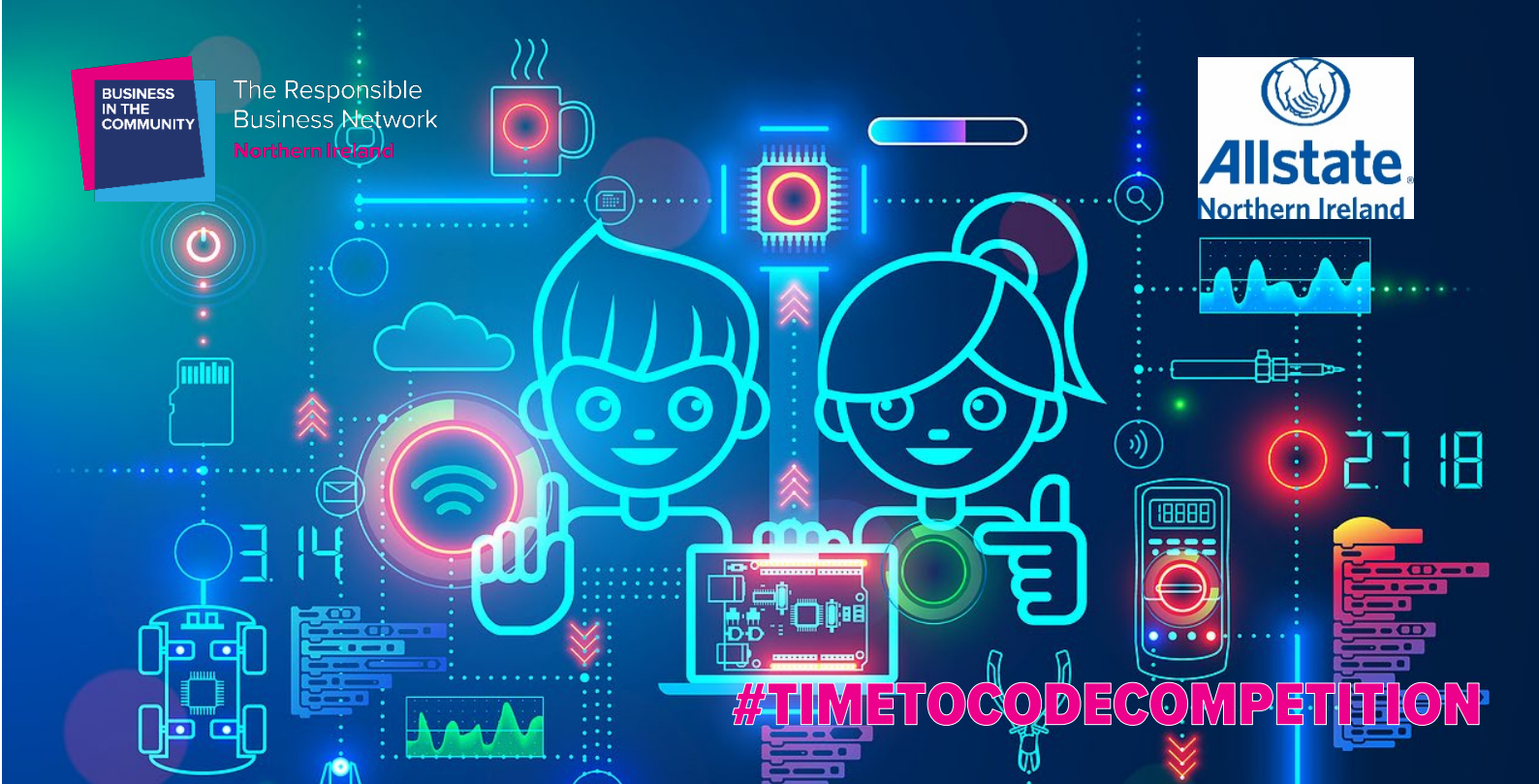

Category One – P4/P5 pupils

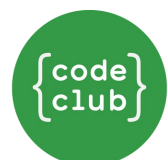
Category One pupils will develop a Scratch project around the theme of “I Am Happy When”
